



FAMILY SUPPORT

Programa de Acceso y Apoyo (Intake & Referral) offers the Latino community bilingual access to community services related to health care, childcare, education, housing, and other critical basic needs.

Legal Services Program makes available free legal counsel from local attorneys on many issues including family law, housing, immigration and employment.

Tax Preparation services assist in tax form preparations, Tax Id Numbers (ITIN), and amendments.

Sabías Qué! (Did you know?) provides the Latino community with the information and tools necessary to access and participate in local systems. The program includes community outreach sessions, formal educational conferences, and community events. ECL partners with representatives from various professional fields to increase awareness of issues of importance to the community.

ADULT EDUCATION & EMPLOYMENT

Adult Education provides skill-building classes to Latinos to gain self-sufficiency skills including English as a Second Language (ESL), Computer Literacy, and the General Equivalency Degree (GED).

Busca Empleo Service (Employment Program) one-on-one consultation assisting Latinos to determine personal skill level, search for employment possibilities, create a resume, and apply for positions.

CHILDREN & YOUTH

Children's Program provides an enriching and safe bilingual experience for preschool children (ages 0-5) whose parents attend adult education classes. The program utilizes the school readiness "Creative Curriculum" helping young children to be prepared to enter kindergarten.

After School Youth Program provides youth (ages 5-13) with a safe place to learn and grow during out-of-school hours, with fun educational activities as well as tutoring, mentoring, and other services from caring adults.

Camp Alianza collaborates with the Chapel Hill-Carrboro School system to provide summer camp opportunities for Latino and African-American children (ages 6-13) from low-income, working families.

HEALTH & WELL BEING

Women's Group offers an opportunity for Latino women to meet each other on a regular basis and learn about topics of interest and importance such as health, safety, and nutrition.

COMMUNITY CONNECTIONS

Programa de Intercambio (Exchange Program) connects Spanish- and English- speakers to develop relationships and share language, customs, and culture.

Fiesta de la Familia bridges communities and facilitates the exchange of information through a cultural festival.
